

DISTINGUISHED SCIENCE ALUMNI AWARD

The Faculty took the opportunity to organise the first-of-its-kind Distinguished Science Alumni Award to honour outstanding alumni in recognition of their professional achievements and contributions to the University and the community. A total of 23 alumni were awarded the Distinguished Science Alumni Award while two of them received the Distinguished Science Alumni Award for Lifetime Achievement.

Mr Wong Chi-yeung, Principal of PLK Mrs Chan Nam Chong Memorial Primary School, is the committee member of the Science Faculty Advisory Board. Mr Wong graduated from HKBU with BSc (Hons) in Mathematical Science and then he continued his studies in Education. Afterwards, he has dedicated himself in the education field for 20 years, and served as a principal for more than 13 years. Being an educator, Mr Wong has received a lot of recognitions, for example, winning the gold award for Po Leung Kuk Outstanding Education Service Contribution (Primary School) in 2014 and being an awardee for Secretary for Home Affairs Commendation Scheme in 2018. Under his leadership, his school has received many awards, such as the Outstanding PLK School Award and Caring School Award Scheme. He has also supported the implementation of the "Initiation programme for newly arrived children" for assisting newly arrived children from different regions of the world. More than 5,200 students benefited from the programme. Besides contributing in the education field, Mr Wong contributed to the society by becoming the Chairman of Wong Tai Sin (East) District Committee of Home Affairs Department, a committee member of the Appeal Board on Closure Orders (Immediate Health Hazard) of Food and Health Bureau, and the Secretary-General of the Kowloon Region School Heads Association.
